

### Introduction

Fair Haven Rape Crisis Center was founded in 2005 with just one program, two volunteers, \$500 and a whole lot of faith! Today, we serve Northwest Indiana as the only designated Rape Crisis Center. Fair Haven advocates serve as the continuum of care within a very complicated system. Victim advocates are the only discipline who walk alongside the survivor throughout the entire process.

In 2021, Fair Haven provided 4,993 services (a 56% increase from 2020) to 316 victims who identified with some form of sexual victimization and/or intimate partner violence.

In 2022, Fair Haven served 469 victims/ survivors (a 48.41% increase in victims served from 2021) and provided 9,103 services (a 105% increase in services from 2021).

In 2023, Fair Haven has served:

#### 498 victims/survivors and provided 7,911 services

including Individual Counseling, Medical Advocacy/Accompaniment to Forensic Exam, Pediatric Exam Accompaniment, Crisis Line Advocacy, Safety Planning, Trauma Therapy, Crisis Intervention, Law Enforcement Interview Advocacy/Accompaniment, Judicial Advocacy, Financial Assistance, Transportation Assistance, Case Management, Language Services, Secondary Services and Animal Therapy.

## Looking Ahead


- With the **Acquisition** (Phase #1) of our current rented office building located in Highland, IN, we will continue to house the Rape Crisis Center operations and community services.
- **Renovation** of the current facility (Phase #2) will consist of a new entrance off the west side of the building, security system, along with cosmetic upgrades.
- **Expansion** (Phase #3) will add four secure non-congregate housing units for adults who are fleeing or attempting to flee from dating violence, sexual assault, stalking or human trafficking.



### Sea the Possibilities

The need to provide 24/7/365 services is one of the most vital and immediate concerns for survivors of sexual violence, intimate partner violence, domestic violence and trafficking. Survivors often struggle with breaking the cycle and require secure housing that will allow them the time and space to decompress and heal.

Our plan includes essential wrap-around services and therapeutic counseling to learn healthy coping skills and unlearn abusive tactics. Victims may also need assistance with separation, divorce, child custody and support, guardianship, adoption, or emancipation.




